Criminal Justice (BA)

This Associate of Arts degree is designed for Colorado Community College System (CCCS) students who want to transfer to UCCS and complete a Bachelor of Arts degree with a major in Criminal Justice. It is based on the <u>best academic advising choices</u> for future UCCS students. To earn the Associate of Arts Degree with Designation (DwD), students must complete the following course requirements for a total of 60 semester credit hours, at least 34 of which must be Colorado State-Guaranteed Courses. Courses taken at other colleges, AP, IB, CLEP, DSST, and other sources of credit may not be applicable upon transfer to UCCS even if applied to the associate's degree at CCCS. UCCS Bachelor of Arts, Criminal Justice Major Requirements

- A minimum of 120 hours must be completed with a cumulative CU grade point average of 2.0; at least 45 of these hours must be at the upper-division level (courses numbered 3000-4999).
- The Criminal Justice major requires a minimum of 42 hours with a grade point average of 2.0, and at least 27 of the hours must be at the upper-division level.
- The last 30 hours of the degree must be completed while registered in the College of Public Service at UCCS.
