Business (BS) – Sport Management Emphasis Completion

This Best Choices Guide is designed for Colorado Community College System (CCCS) students who want to transfer to UCCS and complete a Bachelor of Science degree with a major in Business, Sport Management Emphasis. It is based on the [best academic advising choices](#) for future UCCS students. Please note that final graduation requirements for the bachelor's degree will be based on your year of admission to UCCS. Contact transfer@uccs.edu for more information.

If you plan to complete this bachelor's degree, recognize that:

1. You should transfer into the bachelor's program after you take the courses outlined below. Transfer hours beyond the credits below are not guaranteed to apply toward the bachelor's degree.
2. It is imperative that you contact an advisor at the 4-year institution by the end of the first semester to clarify course work appropriate for this major and to identify the community college courses and GPA necessary to meet admission requirements to both the 4-year institution and the degree program.
3. Each transfer course must have a grade of "C" or better.

This guide does not replace the State-Wide Transfer Articulation Agreement (STAA) for Business, but rather offers an alternative for students who wish to pursue the Sport Management Emphasis in Business at UCCS that is not available via the standard Business STAA.

UCCS Bachelor of Science, Business – Sport Management Emphasis Requirements

1. A minimum of 120 hours must be completed with a cumulative CU grade point average of 2.0; at least 45 of these hours must be at the upper-division level (courses numbered 3000-4999).
2. At least 30 hours of business course work for the degree must be completed while registered in the College of Business at UCCS. The 30 hours must include 18-21 hours in the area of emphasis, BGSO 4000, and STRT 4500.
3. Students must acquire a 2.0 overall GPA and a 2.5 business course GPA to graduate with a specified emphasis, with no grade below a "C-" in all emphasis courses. Students not maintaining this GPA will receive General Business degree at the completion of the program.
