History - Secondary Education Option (BA)

This Associate of Arts degree is designed for Colorado Community College System (CCCS) students who want to transfer to UCCS and complete a Bachelor of Arts degree with a major in History - Secondary Education Option. It is based on the <u>best academic advising choices</u> for future UCCS students. Please note that final graduation requirements for the bachelor's degree will be based on your year of admission to UCCS. Contact <u>transfer@uccs.edu</u> for more information.

To earn the Associate of Arts Degree, students must complete the following course requirements for a total of 60 semester credit hours, at least 34 of which must be Colorado State-Guaranteed Courses. Courses taken at other colleges, AP, IB, CLEP, DSST, and other sources of credit may not be applicable upon transfer to UCCS even if applied to the associate's degree at CCCS. Check the CDHE's <u>GT Pathways</u> website for more information.

To transfer to UCCS, students should have a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or better.

Other AA/AS Requirements

- A minimum of 60 credit hours in a prescribed program of study with a cumulative grade point average of 2.0 (a C average). At least 15 of these credit hours must be earned from CCCS.
- Career and technical courses, whether taken at another institution or at CCCS, are not accepted toward this degree without approval of the CCCS Vice President for Instructional Services. Approval is given only when it is appropriate to the educational objectives of the student.
- Courses numbered below 100/1000 do not apply towards degrees.

Language other than English - UCCS

Beginning fall 2023, the College of Letters, Arts and Sciences (LAS) at UCCS requires all students to complete a language requirement as part of their degree program. Students who have not completed two years of the same world language in high school or have equivalent AP, IB, or CLEP scores are encouraged to take a World Language course 1012, 2011, or 2012 at the community college. World Language credits will fulfill general electives toward the degree, or can apply to a minor. An exemption will be granted to those who complete an Associate's degree prior to their first semester of enrollment at UCCS. Other exemptions and test-out options are available at UCCS. **Contact (transfer@uccs.edu) with questions.**

UCCS Bachelor of Arts, History - Secondary Education Option Major Requirements

- A minimum of 120 hours must be completed with a cumulative CU grade point average of 2.0; at least 45 of these hours must be at the upper-division level (courses numbered 3000-4999).
- Most Education programs require an additional 1-8 credits hours beyond the required 120 hours to complete the degree.
- The History Secondary Education Option major requires a minimum of 30 hours with a grade point average of 2.0, and at least 18 of the hours must be at the upper-division level (courses numbered 3000-4999).
- The last 30 hours of the degree must be completed while registered in the College of Letters, Arts and Sciences at UCCS.
