

# Best Choices Guide

## Music (BA)

This Associate of Arts degree is designed for Colorado Community College System (CCCS) students who want to transfer to UCCS and complete a Bachelor of Arts degree with a major in Music. It is based on the [best academic advising choices](#) for future UCCS students. Please note that final graduation requirements for the bachelor's degree will be based on your year of admission to UCCS. Contact [transfer@uccs.edu](mailto:transfer@uccs.edu) for more information.

To earn the Associate of Arts Degree, students must complete the following course requirements for a total of 60 semester credit hours, at least 34 of which must be Colorado State-Guaranteed Courses. Courses taken at other colleges, AP, IB, CLEP, DSST, and other sources of credit may not be applicable upon transfer to UCCS even if applied to the associate's degree at CCCS. To transfer to UCCS, students should have a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or better.

\*Transfer students who complete all of the listed requirements for the AA may be allowed to take fewer upper-division MUS credit hours (courses numbered 3000 or higher) at UCCS to earn the bachelor's degree. See your UCCS Academic Advisor for details.

### Other AA/AS Requirements

- A minimum of 60 credit hours in a prescribed program of study with a cumulative grade point average of 2.0 (a C average). At least 15 of these credit hours must be earned from CCCS.
- Career and technical courses, whether taken at another institution or at CCCS, are not accepted toward this degree without approval of the CCCS Vice President for Instructional Services. Approval is given only when it is appropriate to the educational objectives of the student.
- Courses numbered below 100/1000 do not apply towards degrees.

### State-Wide Articulation Agreement

### Language other than English - UCCS

Beginning fall 2023, the College of Letters, Arts and Sciences at UCCS requires all students to meet a language requirement equivalent to two semesters of beginner-level instruction in a language other than English before graduation. Students will have fulfilled the requirement upon admission by having completed any of the following equivalents to the first two semesters of language courses (1010/1020) at UCCS: two years of the same world language in high school; AP, IB, or CLEP scores; or completion of a World Language course 1012 or higher in the Colorado Community College System. Exemptions will be granted to students who graduated from high school at least 10 years prior to enrollment in their first UCCS course, veteran and active duty military students in specific situations, and those who have completed an Associate's degree prior to their first semester of enrollment at UCCS. Students may test out of all or part of the requirement by taking a placement exam at UCCS. **Please contact a Transfer Advisor ([transfer@uccs.edu](mailto:transfer@uccs.edu)) with questions.**

### UCCS Bachelor of Arts, Music Major Requirements

- A minimum of 120 hours must be completed with a cumulative CU grade point average of 2.0; at least 45 of these hours must be at the upper-division level (courses numbered 3000-4999).
- The Music major requires a minimum of 52 hours of MUS and 9 hours of VAPA Auxiliary courses, with a grade point average of 2.0, and at least 26\* of the hours must be at the upper-division level (courses numbered 3000-4999). **\*See note on page 1 of this guide.**
- The last 30 hours of the degree must be completed while registered in the College of Letters, Arts and Sciences at UCCS.
