Application Information for Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN): Traditional Option

Students are admitted to UCCS as Pre-Professional Nursing students, and then apply to become Nursing majors to begin the clinical portion of the Nursing program. The clinical portion of the program lasts six semesters. Beth-El admits once per year during the spring semester for the following school year's clinical starts. First Year Courses: All prerequisite courses must be completed successfully by the end of the spring semester of application. Successful completion requires a 3.0 GPA (C- or better for general education courses and a C or better for all HPNU, HSCI and NURS courses).

Minimum GPA: Your cumulative GPA, including all college level course work completed outside of UCCS, must be 3.0 or higher at the end of the spring semester during which you apply to the Traditional Nursing Program. **IMPORTANT:** If your cumulative GPA is less than 3.0 after the final semester update, you will not be considered for admission to the Clinical Nursing Program, even if you have taken and passed the entrance exam. Students have two (2) opportunities to apply to a prelicensure BSN nursing program.

Current Active Students: Applicants must be active students at UCCS in the spring semester that they apply to clinicals.
