Health Care Science – Nutrition Option (BS)

This Associate of General Studies degree is designed for PPCC students who want to transfer to UCCS and complete a Bachelor of Science degree with a major in Health Care Science – Nutrition Option. It is based on the <u>best academic advising choices</u> for future UCCS students.

To earn the Associate of General Studies Degree, students must complete the following course requirements for a total minimum of 60 semester credit hours, at least 30 of which must be general education courses and at least 15 must be from Colorado State-Guaranteed courses. A minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 (C average) must be earned on all courses. At least 15 credit hours must be earned at PPCC. Courses taken at other colleges, AP, IB, CLEP, and other sources of credit may not be applicable upon transfer to UCCS even if applied to the associate's degree at PPCC.

To transfer to UCCS, students should have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or better, *including all remedial and repeated courses*. (Students with a transfer GPA between 2.0 and 2.49 will be considered for admission.) Each transfer course must have a grade of "C" or better.

Foreign Language Note - UCCS

UCCS admission requirements include 2 years of the same high school foreign language (or equivalent 2 semesters at Pikes Peak Community College). Students planning to attend UCCS who do not have the prerequisite foreign language requirement should consider enrolling in these courses in addition to the degree requirements. Students who do not meet this requirement will need to fulfill it upon transferring to UCCS. This admission requirement does not apply to those who

Four-Year Degree Plan – Health Care Science – Nutrition Option

The following four-year plan lists all the specific course requirements for the Bachelor of Science in Health Care Science – Nutrition Option degree at UCCS. PPCC courses are listed in bold. The order in which these courses are taken may vary with course availability. **Students are responsible for completing all course prerequisites.** Please note that this is a *suggested* degree program; your program may vary.

NOTE: Please be aware that completing this program will require an additional 8 credit hours due to specific AGS requirements not required for native UCCS students and due to the difference in credit hours for organic chemistry.

UCCS Bachelor of Science, Health Care Science - Nutrition Option

- 1. A minimum of 120 hours must be completed with a cumulative CU grade point average of 2.0.
- 2. The Health Care Science major requires grades of "C-" or better for all courses. Two grades below "C-" for any required HCSC or option course of two or more credit hours will result in dismissal from the college.
- 3. The last 30 hours of the degree must be completed while registered in the Beth-El College of Nursing & Health Science at UCCS.
- 4. To transfer to UCCS, students should have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or better, *including all remedial and repeated courses*. (Students with a transfer GPA between 2.0 and 2.49 will be considered for admission.) Each transfer course must have a grade of "C" or better.
